1. What is Erasmus+ ?

- ❑ Erasmus+ is the new EU Program for Education, Training, Youth and Sport for 2014-2020, starting in January 2014.
- ❑ Erasmus+ will provide opportunities for over 4 million Europeans to study, train, gain work experience and volunteer abroad.
- ❑ In addition to providing grants for individuals, Erasmus+ will support transnational partnerships.

What is Erasmus+ ?

- ❑ Erasmus+ brings together seven existing EU programs in the fields of Education, Training and Youth; it will for the first time provide support for Sport.

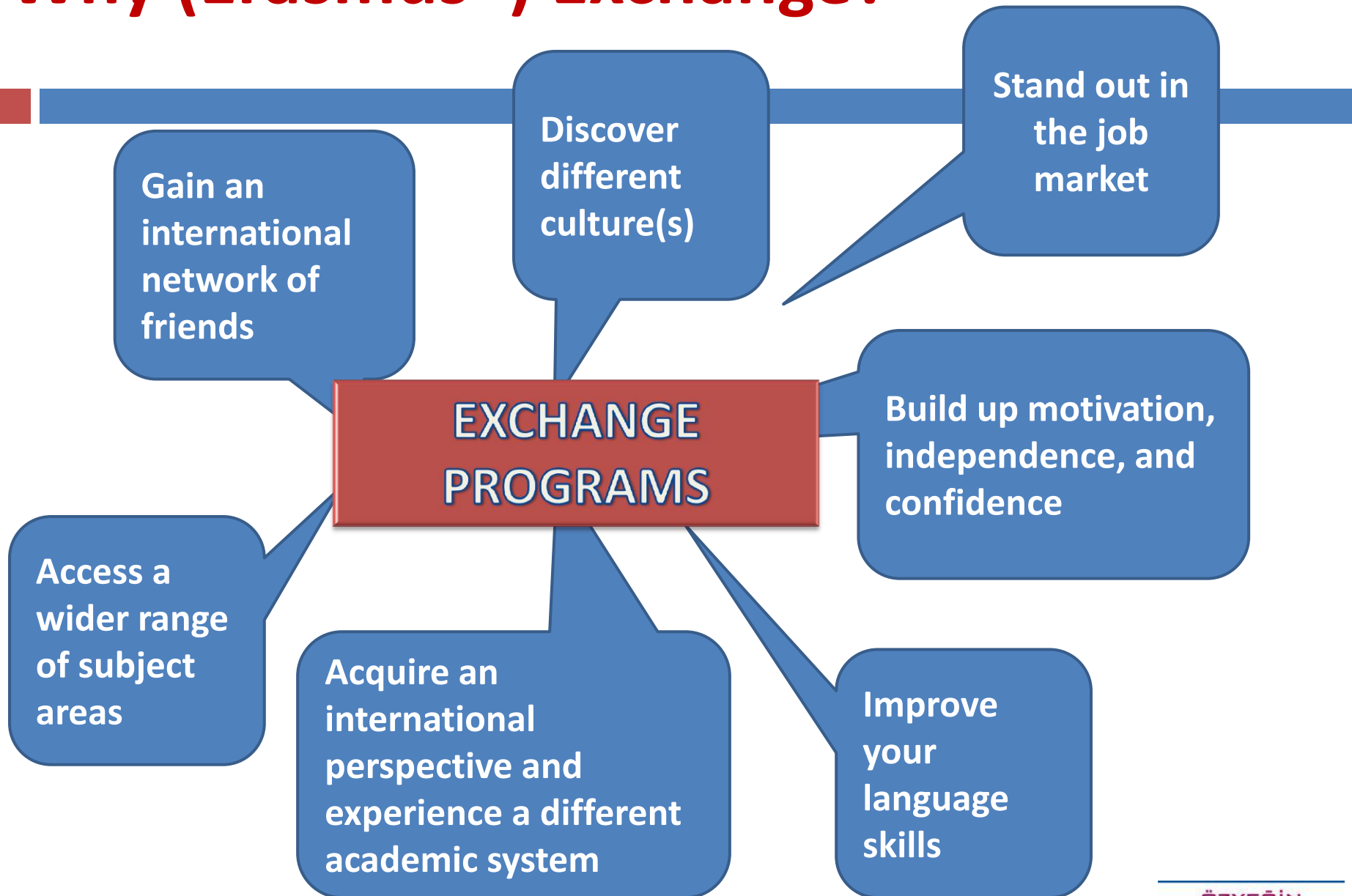

2. Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Study Application / Evaluation Criteria

- ❑ Fall or Spring (3 months – 12 months)
- ❑ Courses taken will be transferred and counted towards OzU graduation requirements. – **You must fill out relevant documentation & receive approvals!**
- ❑ No tuition fee at the host institution, continue to pay your OzU tuition
- ❑ Qualification to apply: **Having completed at least one semester, CGPA \geq 2.20, 60 ELE pts.**
- ❑ Qualification to go:
 - ❑ **Having completed freshman year (60 ECTS).**
 - ❑ **Participants must be full time students who have not obtained all the credits required towards the diploma/degree and has a course load of min. 30 ECTS/semester.**
- ❑ Ranking will be based on «**CGPA 50% + language score 50%**» for institution selections and mobility grants.
 - ❑ **10 points will be deducted** from those who have participated in Erasmus or withdrew from the program after having accepted to go.
 - ❑ **10 points will be added** to those who submit their Disabled Identity Card and Veterans/Martyrs ID Card.
 - ❑ **10 points will be deducted** from students who participate to the program in their countries of citizenship.
- ❑ You may apply for both Erasmus+ and Global Exchange. If you are slotted to both programs for the same semester, you must withdraw from one within the deadline presented by the IO.
- ❑ Quotas, dates, and requirements of partner institutions are subject to change based on their internal decisions.

Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Study

Application Dates/Deadlines

- **English Language Exam (ELE) – 11 February 2017.**
 - ▣ Score: 60/100 to qualify
 - ▣ Scores are valid for two years.
 - ▣ If you took during the 15-16 academic year, you do not have to retake.
- **Erasmus+ Application Steps:**
 1. Apply to Erasmus+ online and select your institutions of interest:
23 January – 6 February 2017
 2. Take the ELE on **11 February 2017, 10 am.**
 3. ELE scores will be announced late February.
 4. Ranking & placement results will be announced approximately early March.
 5. Submit your commitment form by **March 20th** ; otherwise you will not be nominated to the partner institution and you will be automatically withdrawn from the program.

Erasmus Student Mobility for Study

□ Second round placement:

- Students who are not placed during the 1st evaluation period will be invited to make institution selections with the remaining available quotas.
- Students who are placed but fail to submit their commitment forms on time will not be invited to make institution selections during the second round placement.
- Placement will take place in Summer 2017.

Erasmus Student Mobility for Study

Erasmus+ Mobility grants

- ❑ Will be announced late summer by the Turkish National Agency
- ❑ Are limited.
- ❑ Do not base your decision on the mobility grants.
- ❑ In line with the National Agency rules, to support more students, OzU will fund max. 4 months based on the total mobility budget.

How to choose your Erasmus Destination?

- ❑ Availability of courses that can be transferred towards OzU graduation requirements
 - ❑ Faculty/Institute/School Executive Board transfers the credits earned based on the **ECTS Transcript of Records** from the host institution after the mobility.
- ❑ You are expected to take 30 ECTS/semester
- ❑ No overlap in academic semesters
- ❑ Language of instruction
- ❑ Please select your institutions after careful consideration of all available info – you will not have the chance to change your selections later.

You must talk to your exchange program coordinator in advance after carefully studying potential institutions of interest!

Please note that tentative course lists may change even after you arrive at the host destination.

How to choose your Erasmus Destination?

- ❑ Services offered: housing, orientation etc.
- ❑ Cost of living (housing, visa/residence permit, health insurance, travel, food, etc.)
 - ▣ Some countries strongly suggest/require certain international policies for immigration purposes.
- ❑ Cultural, social, travelling opportunities
- ❑ Visa/residence permit related costs
 - ▣ Some countries like the Netherlands require residence permit fees around 300 EUR.
- ❑ Other professional and/or personal preferences

Once you submit your commitment form to the IO by March 20th ...

- ❑ You will be nominated to the host institution by the OzU IO. Do not get in touch with them before you receive an email regarding applications!
- ❑ Apply to the host institution in line with their instructions before their deadlines.
- ❑ Receive your acceptance letter from the host institution
Acceptance is never guaranteed!
- ❑ Visa, insurance, travel, accommodation arrangements etc. are **YOUR OWN** responsibility. You must review the requirements of the host institutions as well as respective Consulate/Embassies.
- ❑ Fill out necessary documents directed by the IO/host institutions.

- Apply to Erasmus+ & list your university choices – **23 January – 6 February 2017**
- Take the Erasmus English Language Exam – **11 February 2017, 10 am.**
- Faculty ranking based on the CGPA & Language Exam
- Submit your commitment form to the OzU IO – **20 March 2017**
- Submit your 2nd language proficiency report, if applicable – **20 March 2017** (for students who will study in a language other than English)
- We are using a new application system , please do not make any assumptions based on your previous experiences.

- ❑ Nomination by the OzU International Office
- ❑ After nomination, complete your online application to the partner institution by their deadline
- ❑ Complete health insurance, visa, travel, housing etc. related arrangements after acceptance. – **Your own responsibility!**

Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Placement/Internship (for Summer 2017)

3. Erasmus Student Mobility for Placement (for Summer 2017)

- ❑ Erasmus student placement = **INTERNSHIP**
- ❑ Minimum 2 months, maximum 12 months.
- ❑ The sector and enterprise must be compatible with the applicants' diploma program.
- ❑ Enterprise or organization in line with the program rules. EU institutions, EU funded projects and EU agencies not eligible as host institutions. The receiving organization can be any public or private organization active in the labor market or in the fields of education, training and youth. For example, such organization can be:
 - ❑ public or private, a small, medium or large enterprise (including social enterprises);
 - ❑ public body at local, regional or national level;
 - ❑ social partner or other representative of working life, including chambers of commerce, craft/professional associations and trade unions;
 - ❑ research institute or foundation;
 - ❑ school/institute/educational center (at any level, from pre-school to upper secondary education, and including vocational education and adult education);
 - ❑ non - profit organization, association, NGO;
 - ❑ body providing career guidance, professional counselling and information services;
 - ❑ Program Country HEI awarded with an ECHE.

Erasmus Student Mobility for Placement (Summer 2017)

Qualification to apply:

- Having completed one semester in the diploma program,
 - undergraduate students CGPA ≥ 2.20 ,
 - graduate students CGPA ≥ 3.00 , must submit academic advisors approval,
 - min. 60/100 points in ELE.
- Ranking for the **mobility grants** among those who find a placement: **CGPA 50%, English 50%.**
- **10 points will be deducted** from those who have participated in Erasmus or withdrew from the program after having accepted to go.
 - **10 points will be added** to those who submit their Disabled Identity Card and Veterans/Martyrs ID Card.
 - **10 points will be deducted** from students who participate to the program in their countries of citizenship.
- Mobility grant for approximately 12 OzU students, 2 months each.
- If you plan to make an internship during the summer of 2017, then you must apply now and take the ELE in February.

Mandatory Internship and Erasmus+ Placements

- Erasmus placement can be counted towards the mandatory internship, **BUT**
- You'll need to meet the mandatory internship pre-requisites **AND** the internship has to be separately approved by your Faculty.
- **ALSO**, your internship abroad might qualify for Faculty but **NOT** for Erasmus (e.g. not in an approved country or shorter than min period).

Placement Mobility Deadlines

Summer 2017

- ❑ IO will not find you enterprises. You must find your own placement so research about enterprises and apply individually.
- ❑ Apply between **23 January – 6 February 2017.**
- ❑ Take the ELE on **11 February 2017.**
- ❑ Present an acceptance/invitation letter from the company to the OzU IO via email to complete your application by the following deadline: **31 March 2017.**
- ❑ Evaluation results will be announced approximately mid April.
