How to Choose the Exchange Destination?

- Availability of courses in English that can be transferred back towards MBA graduation requirements
- Contribution to your professional development
- No overlap in the academic semesters
- Services offered: housing, orientation etc.
- Cost of living
- Cultural, social, travelling opportunities

1. Non-Erasmus Exchanges

- Exchange Study at a partner institution
- Fall/ Spring or Module
- Courses taken transferred back home and counted towards OzU graduation requirements
- No tuition fee at host institution, continue to pay what is your normal OzU tuition
- Qualification: **CGPA \geq 3.00**
- Ranking for choice of destination: **CGPA and Interview** with the Faculty Jury.
- **TOEFL required** for most partners; min score varies but around 80-100 (IBT)— take it at the latest January 2013!

How the Process Works...

- Apply to be included in the non-Erasmus exchange study program
- Get selected by the OzU Graduate School of Business and get your course selection approved by your academic advisor
- The IO nominates you to the partner institution
- Complete - **ONLY after nomination** - the application to the host institution
- Get accepted by the host institution, take care of your visa, insurance, travel, accommodation arrangements – **YOUR OWN** responsibility
- After the exchange semester, the Institute Executive Board transfers the credits earned based on the official transcript from the host institution

2. Erasmus Student Mobility for Study

- Exchange Study at Erasmus partner institution (EU-27)
- Fall/Spring (min 3 months)
- Courses taken transferred back home and counted towards OzU graduation requirements
- No tuition fee at host institution, continue to pay what is your normal OzU tuition
- Qualification to go: **CGPA \geq 3.0**
- Ranking for choice of destination and mobility grants: **CGPA 50%, English 50% (TOEFL, IELTS, TRACE)**

How the Process Starts ...

- Apply to be included in the Erasmus exchange study program
- Get ranked for choice of destination and mobility grant -
Even then, mobility grants are NEVER guaranteed
- Get nominated by the Erasmus Institutional Coordinator
- With the IRO, complete - ONLY after nomination - the application to the host institution
- **LEARNING AGREEMENT** with your Erasmus Program Coordinator

How the Process Continues...

- Get accepted by the host institution, complete more Erasmus documents
- Take care of your visa, insurance, travel, accommodation arrangements – **YOUR OWN** responsibility
- More Erasmus documents to complete during and after the stay
- Institute Executive Board transfers the credits earned based on the **ECTS Transcript of Records** from the host institution and **Proof of Recognition** prepared by Erasmus Program Coordinators

Apply by **November 30th** by filling out the forwarded application form and sending out supplemental documents.

(For both Fall 2013 and Spring 2014)

For Erasmus:

- Apply after you get your CGPA end of Fall semester
- On-line application link will open in February 2013
- **Deadline for Erasmus Exchange Study: Feb., 28th, 2013**
