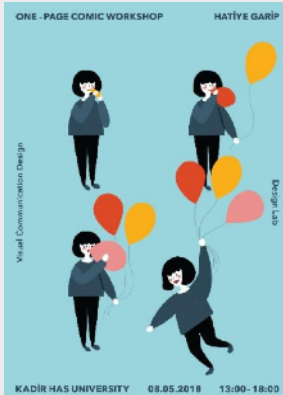

Editorial



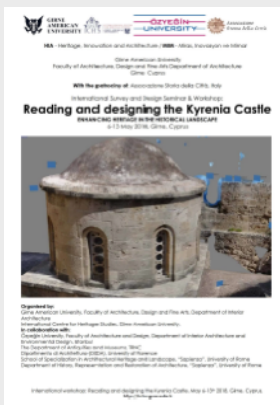
The project of new building of Faculty of Architecture and Design was finished at June 2018. Faculty of Architecture and Design building was designed by ARK – Roger Klein a USA based architecture company who also designed the main master plan and many buildings in the Çakmeköy Campus. The building covers not only FAD but also some laboratories of Engineering Faculty. The main architectural composition of the building is based on 6 meters high open studio spaces on the West looking over forrest which have split level organization according to slope on the site and a section which has 3 meters high office and seminar rooms on the east side of the architectural mass. This open studio will give opportunity to obtain flexible space organization with model making stations and pin-up spaces, jury spaces around the open studio spaces. Studios will have 1400 students capacity which is the total steady state number of students planned for the faculty including one more department planned to open in the following years. The main entrance and the main approach to building will be from the existing main quad area. The new facility of FAD will have computer labs, media lab, visual reality (VR) lab, user experience (UX) lab, digital fabrication lab, model workshop, design and built workshop, ceramic workshop, building materials and physics lab besides the other educational and service spaces. The construction of new building is planned to start at July 2018 and the building is planned to open to use at September 2019.



- Emotional First Aid training course was held at Bomontiada- ATÖLYE on the 11th of April by Suzi Amado.

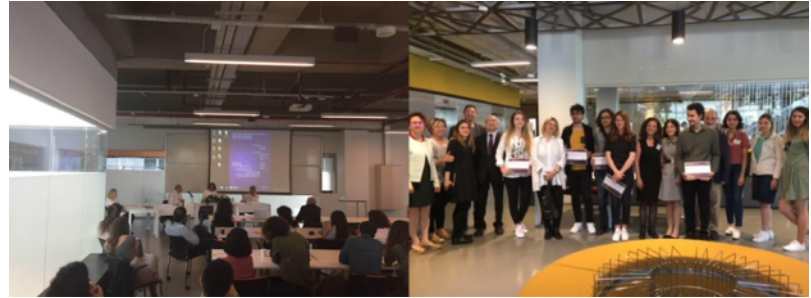

National Symposium of Architectural Design Research II: Future of Cities was held at Özyeğin University Campus in Çekmeköy between the dates 25-27 April 2018. As the basic events of the symposium; 5 sessions in two days, 5 workshops, 2 exhibitions were held, products of the workshops exhibited and also 41 students' projects related with urban design were exhibited and 5 of them were awarded.
