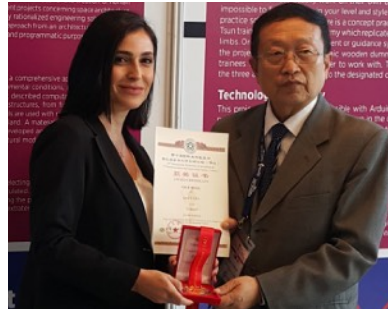

ÖzÜ Faculty Member Dr. Sevil Yazıcı won two Gold Medals in two international organisations held in China and Turkey for her work titled 'Design and Manufacturing Method for a Building System in Regards to Structural and

Environmental Factors', which is currently pending for patents both in the US and Turkey.

One of her medals was given by the '10th International Exhibition of Inventions & 3rd World Invention and Innovation Forum' held in 13-15 September 2018 at Foshan-China. About 4000 inventions from 61 countries were contributed to the event titled "Inventions Make Dreams Come True, Innovation Leads the Trends for Tomorrow". She received her award from Dr. Zengpei Xuan, the Deputy Secretary General of China Association of Inventions, during the 3rd Istanbul International Invention Fair in 27-29 September 2018, held in Lütfü Kırdar Congress Hall.

Another medal she won was presented in the 3rd Istanbul International Invention Fair, in which the jury evaluated about 400 inventions from 30 countries. It is the first and only international organization in Turkey related to inventions, hosted by Turkish Patent and Trade Name Organization (Türk Patent) and supported by International Federation of Inventors' Associations (IFIA); European Patent Office (EPO) World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and the Ministry of Science, Industry and Technology.

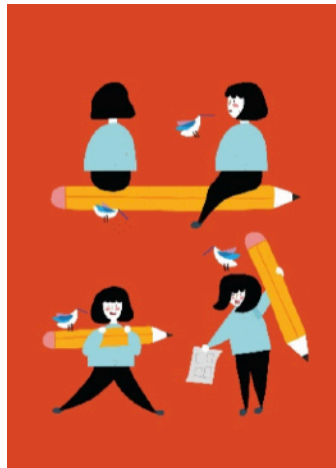

of Technology, Design and Environment at Oxford Brookes University in 2017, and her doctoral research which focused on the management of global heritage cities, was awarded three fellowships and was shortlisted for two prestigious awards. In the meanwhile, she worked as an Associate Lecturer in the School of Architecture at Oxford Brookes University and combined research, teaching and consultancy practices in Istanbul and Oxford. Since 2017, Dr. İkiz Kaya has been working as a Lecturer in Architectural Conservation, Regeneration and Design at Ozyegin University. Her current research focuses on the management of historic urban landscapes located within global cities with a new focus on heritage management practices within an Islamic context. This research is planned to be published as a research monograph by the end of 2019. She has also worked in other international collaborative research projects and widely published on the broader topics of contested heritage, identity building and heritage protection specifically in the Eastern Europe and Middle East regions.



Associate Professor Dr. Alessandro Camiz, graduated (MSc) in Architecture at “Sapienza” University (Rome, 1999). Before graduating he cooperated with Sartogo Architetti Associati in the project for the New Italian Embassy (Washington DC) and the Church of Jesus’ Holy Face (Rome). In 2007 discussed his doctoral thesis on “History of medieval town planning in Ravenna” (Sapienza), and there attended postdoctoral studies until 2014. Has taught at the School of Architecture (University of Miami), and at the Faculty of Architecture of Girne American University (Cyprus). His research interests are in the fields of architectural design, urban morphology and history of architecture.
