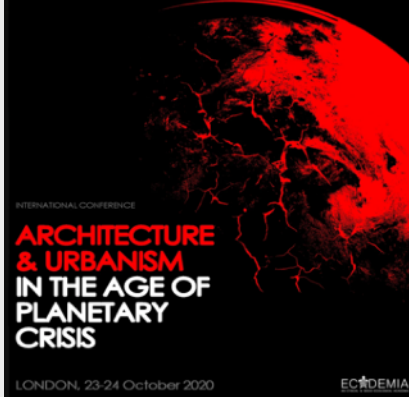

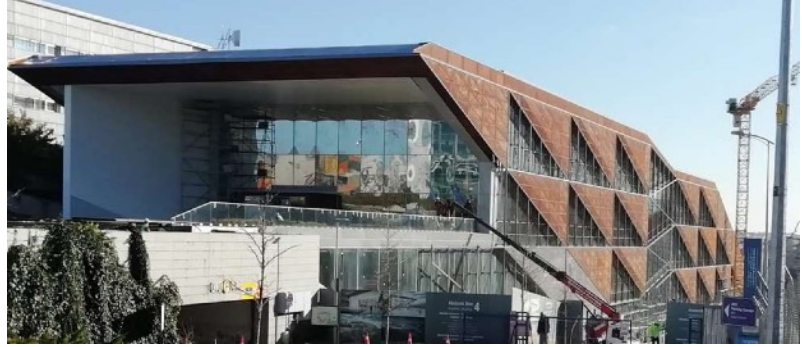
News

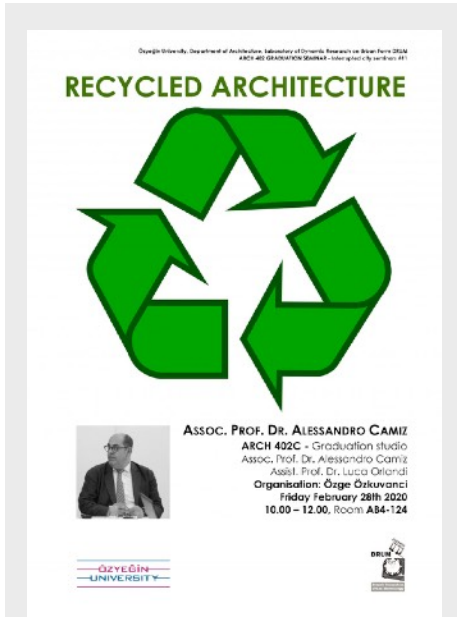
