Since the effects of global epidemic situation have been continuing in our country, Higher Education Council (YOK) conveyed a notification to higher education institutions in line with the recommendation of the Ministry of Health. Considering this notification, the Ozyegin

University Senate decided to convert the courses totally online, which had been firstly planned to be given face-to face with synchronous option in the Fall 2020 Academic Year.

Apparently, the difficult conditions of the distance education process were accomplished with hard work, mutual tolerance, trust and great effort during the Spring Term, which had started unprepared. A new academic period has been starting, which will be processed online.
