Final Grades that Contribute to the GPA</b>	<p>Undergraduate students with a minimum CGPA of 2,00 at the end of any semester are deemed 'Satisfactory', while students with a CGPA lower than 2,00 at the end of any given semester are deemed to be 'on Probation'. At the end of any given semester, among students with a cumulative grade point average of at least 2,00, those with an SGPA between 3,00 and above are deemed 'High Honor' students, provided that they have completed at least 24 ECTS credits with the passing grades and have not received any Fall grade (F or U).</p> <p>Academic standing is not calculated for other levels.</p>
